Medical Standard:

- Physical Standards: Candidates should be healthy and physically fit for sea service as per STCW 95/MS Medical rules 2000 as applicable to seafarers. Candidates will have to undergo a full medical check up by a Company Medical Officer.

- Eyesight: +/- 2.5 permitted. Normal colour vision. Candidates will have to undergo a full eyesight test by a Company Medical Officer and sight test by Mercantile Marine Department.

- Medical test cost Rs.1200/- (Approx)

Admission Procedure:

Eligible candidates will be called for medical test, interview and final selection
Medical and Interview will take place at Mumbai.

- The Company will not provide any lodging, boarding, travelling or any other incidental expenses to the candidates incurred during admission process
